Accommodations

We offer three lodging options year-round, from the rustic camp cabin to the premium hotel room experience. Groups must fill one lodging area completely before a second area is available.

CEDAR LODGE

Capacity: 22 rooms, 61 beds Cedar Lodge has 22 hotel-style rooms with private baths. Each room is equipped with a microwave and mini-refrigerator and can house three to five people, with queen, double, twin, and bunk bed combinations. Bed & bath linens are provided. Cedar Lodge has heating and air conditioning.





MOUNTAIN VIEW

Capacity: 96-120 Mountain View cabins have 12 cabins, sleeping eight campers each in bunk beds. Each cabin is carpeted and can be divided into two smaller suites of four with one private bathroom per suite. Two cabins have open floor plans, providing accessibility for persons with disabilities. Mountain View guests provide their own bed & bath linens. The cabins have heat, and fans are provided.

WESTVIEW

Capacity: 88-101 Our 11 Westview cabins provide the traditional camp experience. These cabins have four to five bunks and sleep eight to ten people each. Renovated cabins have a toilet and sink, and all cabins share a nearby shower house. Guests provide their own bed & bath linens. The cabins have heat, and fans are provided.

WHAT IS INCLUDED WITH OUR RETREAT?

Your package includes lodging, meals, one meeting space, and some non-staffed activities. Throughout your retreat, a host is available to answer questions and assist as needed. Your group may enjoy our hiking trails, sports courts, and playing field.

WHO DECIDES THE MENU?

Depending on the group size, you may have the option to select meals before arrival based on a preset menu. If multiple groups are on-site simultaneously, you may not able to select your meals, but you will receive an advance copy of the menu. We can accommodate most special diets and allergies. Free coffee and tea are available from 7 am to 7 pm daily in the Dining Hall.

WILL WE BE SHARING SPACE WITH OTHER GROUPS?

We have guests on site nearly every day of the year, so it is possible another group will be booked during your stay. Exclusive use is not guaranteed. Each group enjoys a private meeting space and lodging, while sharing the Dining Hall and grounds.

WHAT TYPES OF MEETING SPACES ARE AVAILABLE?

We have multiple meeting spaces with capacities ranging from 15 to 250 guests. As part of your package, your group will receive one meeting space determined by group size and may rent out additional spaces if available. A basic audio/visual set up is included with each meeting space and additional equipment may be available for rent.

WHAT IF WE HAVE A MEDICAL EMERGENCY?

Guest Groups are required to have a designated person trained in First Aid and CPR. Oakhurst has three urgent care facilities, and Fresno hospitals are within an hour's drive. Please note that Calvin Crest does not have a nurse on-site.

WHY IS A CONTRACT AND DEPOSIT REQUIRED?

To secure your dates, a signed contract and 20% non-refundable deposit are required. A contract offers security for both parties, ensuring your reservation is set on our calendar and will not be cancelled for another group. It also protects Calvin Crest by establishing guaranteed income from your event. Finally, a contract clearly communicates all the details and expectations of both parties.

WHY ARE MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM PARTICIPANT NUMBERS NECESSARY?

A guaranteed minimum number of participants helps Calvin Crest remain sustainable and helps us know how many rooms or cabins to reserve for your event. If a group has fewer guests than anticipated, the group is still responsible to pay for the guaranteed minimum. If a group exceeds their established maximum, we will do our best to accommodate housing needs as possible.

WHAT IS THE CANCELLATION POLICY?

If a group cancels at any point after establishing a contract, the deposit is nonrefundable. If the event is cancelled by the group at 90 days or less prior to the event, the group is responsible for the financial amount due of the guaranteed minimum.
